Description

The City of Raleigh has received and will continue to receive funding authorization to provide a full year of high frequency fixed-route bus service along the Hillsborough Street corridor in FY23. The Wake Transit Plan's original terminus for this service west of I-440 will not be practical until the ongoing NCDOT road improvement project on Blue Ridge Rd is complete. Until that time, the western terminus for the service will be near the intersection of Method Road & Ligon Street. In FY25, there are no other modifications apart from the annual inflationary factor of 2.5% over the previous year's funding, which received an increase in FY24 to cover an increase costs per service hour.
